RGS Gun Dog Fun Hunt Guidelines

This is a very low key, but well organized social event. Bring the entire family out and enjoy the day. You will be able to interact with all the various breeds and watch them run with conveniences from an on-site clubhouse. Mingle with fellow dog owners whom share a common interest. It doesn't matter what age or level of training your dog has, even if they haven't been exposed to birds before. Bring them out to run, socialize, and have some fun!

- This is not a competition. There will be no judging or awards given. This is strictly for fun.
- ***New this year*** - We will allow two people to carry a gun in the field unless there is a youth shooting. Then, only the youth will be allowed to carry a gun.
- Flushing and Pointing dogs of all ages and experience are welcome. There will be shooting so take proper precautions with young dogs that haven't been exposed to gunfire.
- We will have use of a rustic clubhouse and there will be a portable restroom and wash basin on site. We advise people that want to sit outside to bring folding chairs.
- Dogs need to be leashed, kenneled, or staked out when not in the field.
- All participants are required to wear blaze orange covering at least 25% of their body while in the field.
- Safety/shooting glasses must be worn in the field. We advise spectators to wear them as well.
- Facility requires us to use shells with steel or tungsten shot (no lead shot allowed) with #7, 8, or 9 shot size. These regulations have to be honored. If you have trouble finding shells, contact **Brad Johnson** (see contact info on registration form).
- You will have 30 minutes to run your dog and find your birds. Re-flushes are permitted as long as the bird stays within the boundaries of the same field.
- A minimum of 2 birds per dog must be purchased (no maximum number). We will be using chuckar partridge for this event. Please keep the birds you shoot.
- Youngsters registered in the DNR mentor program will be allowed to carry a gun under the guided supervision of a parent/guardian. All Michigan DNR mentor guidelines must be followed.
- We will allow up to 4 people to walk behind a dog. We encourage family and friends to walk together. All people must wear blaze orange and safety glasses. Only exception is if a youth is shooting. Then **only** his/her mentor will be allowed in the field with them.
- Be at the start line ready to go 10 minutes before your hunt is scheduled to start. This will give us time to locate you and go over a few safety reminders while your birds are being planted.
- All electronic devices (e-collars, beepers, GPS collars, etc.) are allowed to be used.
- If you have a female pup, please let us know if the event date may coincide with a heat cycle. We will designate special run times for them.
