gravel road. First right into Central Virginia Sporting Clays.

**From Farmville:** North on Route 15.  
Left on Route 6 at Fork Union about 7 miles.  
Right at Kidds Store on Route 620 (Rolling Road)  
Right on Route 639 (Long Acre Road)  
Left on Route 680 (Middle Fork Road) gravel road  
First right into Central Virginia Sporting Clays.
