RGS at Work: Projects and Activities



MAP Projects

Funding is provided to public land managers through RGS' Management Area Program (MAP) to support essential wildlife habitat development. Over 500,000 acres of federal, state and county lands have been directly affected.

Seminars & On-Site Consultations

RGS helps present seminars and wildlife habitat improvement consultations for landowners and managers to learn forest management techniques.

Regional Biologists

A staff of biologists work regionally on habitat projects with volunteers and conservation partners to improve young-forest habitat on private and public land.

Conservation Policy

RGS works with legislators, agencies and policy makers to ensure forests are managed in an ecologically sound manner.

Research

RGS encourages research that continues to add to the store of knowledge of how to most effectively manage forest wildlife habitat.

Banquets & Volunteers

Numerous banquets are held annually by volunteers and RGS staff to raise funds for habitat projects.

International Activities

An affiliated Ruffed Grouse Society of Canada carries the young-forest wildlife conservation campaign into the provinces.



Since 1985 RGS has spent almost \$3,000,000 on over 500 habitat projects.
