We will meet at noon for lunch (*included in the price*) and then shoot 100 targets on the landscaped course, beginning at **1 PM**.

Participants will be paired in groups of five, and will start at different stations to allow most to finish around the same time.

The top three shooters will be recognized, but this is a fun shoot, that will allow you to get out with your shotgun and have some fun, as well as meet other members from the Virginia chapters.

You are encouraged to form your own 5 man squads, or just be paired into a squad.

A free golf cart option will be provided for the day to the first sixteen RGS members who get their fees to me; we have four carts available that will usually take four to a cart.

Otherwise we will all walk the course. I will hold a few spots on the cart for anyone who feels they are unable to walk the course; please identify yourself when you register.

\$55 Fee – Includes lunch and access to the 100 clay course.

You are responsible for providing your own shotgun shells and shotgun; the largest shell allowed is a #7.5 load.

Safety will be paramount; never load your weapon unless you are in the cage ready to shoot.

Break all shotguns between stations that are "breakable", and leave the receiver in open position in those shotguns that don't break such as automatics.

Eye and ear protection required.
