From Grand Rapids take US-131 to Exit 162. Go west on 14 Mile Rd. Go 4.3 miles and turn north on Raymond Rd. Go 6 miles and turn west on 6 Mile Rd. In 2 miles you will cross the Pine River Bridge. Saddler Rd. will be just past the bridge. 100 yards past Saddler Rd. is a 2-track on your left. Follow that south to the meeting location. Watch for signs.
