RGS has degreed biologists on the ground nationwide and RGS-owned forest management equipment implementing a proven plan for forest management.

### Management Area Program

The RGS MAP program has created over 600 projects affecting over 500,000 acres of habitat in 28 states.

### RGS Government Affairs and Policy

The RGS Director of Conservation Policy has an impact on legislation and policy in Washington D.C., and RGS staff are members of congressional and state committees affecting our natural resources and hunting rights.

### Coverts Program

The RGS Coverts Program works with cooperative extension services and has affected over 1 million acres of forest habitat.

### Consulting Forester Outreach Program

This new program targets private landowners through educational seminars for foresters performed by RGS biologists.
